GRID GARDINING PLANTING PLAN

Place a plant in each 1ft by 1ft space on the grid symbolizing a 3ft by 6ft raised garden bed.

For larger plants, like tomatoes and squash or plants that need trellises, allow 2 spaces.

For taller plants like corn or beans, consider planting them on one side to either create afternoon shade or to prevent afternoon shade, depending on where you live!
